**Glass—NO curbside pickup:
Glass is accepted as drop off
only at Hawkeye Recycling**

Acceptable: Only CLEAR glass.
i.e. food jars, pop bottles, juice
bottles, baby food jars, liquor bot-
tles

Non Acceptable: COLORED
glass. i.e. light bulbs, drinking
glasses, baking dishes, window
glass, crystal, ceramics

Plastics

Acceptable: (#1, #2)

Kitchen: milk jugs, soft drink,
juice, liquor, water, cooking oil,
dish soap, window cleaner con-
tainers.

Bathroom: shampoo, conditioner,
mouthwash, lotion, cleaners, liquid
hand soap containers.

Laundry: liquid detergent, fabric
softener, bleach containers.

Automotive: windshield washer
containers

Non Acceptable: motor oil bot-
tles, antifreeze, toys, pesticides,
herbicides, solvent, paint, flower
pots, garden plastics, Tupperware
and microwave containers,
Styrofoam and polystyrene.

Metal

Acceptable: tin food cans, pop
cans, aluminum food and beverage
containers.

Non Acceptable: aerosol contain-
er, paints, solvents, adhesives, gas
or chemical cans, pesticides, herbi-
cides.

Paper

Acceptable: office and computer
paper, catalogs, phone books,
magazines, junk mail, newsprint.

Cardboard

All corrugated cardboard must be
recycled as it has been banned
from the Winneshiek County
Landfill and Floyd Mitchell Land-
fill

There is a 5 bag per week maximum pick up for garbage before additional charges are added. Containers shall not weigh more than 60 pounds. Items not picked up with garbage: cardboard, sharps, tires, TVs, appliances, yard waste, batteries, paint, oil, Freon containers, toxic or poisonous materials, computers, wire, fence posts, bricks, iron, cement chunks, animal carcasses, and fertilizer.

Charges for additional items: Sofa-\$10; hide-a-bed-\$15; recliner-\$7.50, small chair-\$5; mattress and/or box spring-\$6 each
Extra garbage assessed by driver: household-\$38.50/cu yd; construction-\$48.50/cu yd; shingles-\$58.50/cu yd



HOW AND WHAT TO RECYCLE


Start by placing three paper bags into your recycling bin.




Use the bags to sort your recyclables.

If you wish to recycle glass you may do so at our recycling facility in Cresco: 811 Airport Road</p>	<p>Corrugated, cereal boxes or other food boxes. Remove plastic linings or windows.</p>

<p>Newspaper and magazines. Bundle or place in paper bags.</p> 	<p>Milk and water jugs, soda bottles and other containers with the numbers (1 + 2) No styrofoam or polystyrene. No plastic bags. No oil containers. Please remove lids & rinse. Flatten for more space</p> 	<p>Please rinse cans. Remove labels. Flatten for more space.</p>
